

## Ballachey Moore law firm brings expertise to Caledonia

For Matt Lambert, expanding the Ballachey Moore LLP law firm to Caledonia was the next logical step for the Caledonia-native. "I've been a lawyer for four years," said Lambert. "Because I'm from Caledonia, I wanted to get a foot in the door here where my networking is already done for me."

As of January, Lambert became one of three partners at the Ballachey Moore law firm, which originated in Brantford. The senior partners at the firm are Karl Beyer and William Harrow.

His first move as a partner was to bring the firm's expertise to the community he grew up in. Ballachey Moore focuses on civil litigation, particularly, in personal injury law, which includes slips and falls and motor vehicle accidents.

"That's different than what the other firms in Caledonia do," explained Lambert. "That is what

makes us unique especially in Haldimand County.

"We're a local firm that does motor vehicle accidents and personal injury law."

He felt that personal injury law is a service that's not available in Caledonia, and he wants to bring in his firm to help represent those who would otherwise have to leave the town to find representation.

Lambert was born and raised in Caledonia, growing up to watch both his parents and uncle run businesses in town. While he moved to Brantford two years ago for his firm, like every other Caledonia-native, he found himself drawn back into the community that had watched him flourish.

And because he has roots in Caledonia, he said what makes his firm unique is the promise of one-on-one consultation with clients.

"You're going to get a more personal and hands-on feel with us as opposed to a bigger firm where you

time," said Lambert. "We're different because we're a smaller operation. You're

going to get more personal service." Along with personal inju-

ry law, and all areas of civil litigation, the firm also does real estate and corporate and commercial work.

The Ballachey Moore law firm built a name for itself in Brantford, where its original founders started the firm over 60 years ago.

Today, the firm's three partners continue to offer comprehensive, personal service to their clients that made Ballachey Moore well-respected in Brantford, and Lambert plans to bring that strong reputation to Caledonia.

The Caledonia office is located at 45 Caithness St. E., near the Legion.

The location is currently used as a consultation office with a lawyer available on Thursdays as well as by appointment, but Lambert said the long-term goal is to have the office open full time.
